For more than a decade, the City of La Habra has been recognized by the Arbor Day Foundation for excellence in urban forestry and its commitment to Earth Day, earning the coveted "Tree City USA" designation. As in years past, the City will host an educational fair on Saturday, April 26, 2014, to promote the conservation of trees in La Habra. The event will be held at El Centro Park, located at 320 East Erna Avenue, from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

In addition to sharing helpful information on trees, the City's tree maintenance partner, West Coast Arborists, will donate free seedlings to the public. Waste Management, the City's designated trash hauler, will also be at the fair and donate free mulch to La Habra residents on a first-come, first-serve basis. Residents are limited to one plastic trash bag (maximum size 40 gallons) of mulch per person and MUST bring their own trash bags, as well as proof of residency.
