### Orange County Reopening Guidelines



Effective: September 8, 2020

As of August 31, 2020, the Blueprint for a Safer Economy replaces the County Data Monitoring list for determining what businesses can and cannot open. This update reflects the revised criteria and the time between changing tiers. The four tier color-coded system would match a color to each of the four tiers with purple representing the highest “widespread” risk level for a county with more than seven new cases per 100,000 residents and more than 8 percent positivity rate. Red will represent “substantial” risk, while orange represents “moderate” risk and yellow the lowest level, “minimal” risk, with those lower levels being determined by reduced numbers in case and positivity rates.

Orange County’s current risk level, as determined by the State of California, is “substantial” (red tier); which means many non-essential indoor business operations may re-open with modifications. At a minimum, counties must remain in an assigned tier for at least three weeks before moving to a lower level tier. Data is reviewed weekly and tiers are updated by the State every Tuesday. To move to a lower risk tier, a county must meet the next tier’s criteria for two consecutive weeks. If a county’s COVID-19 case rates and data worsen for two consecutive weeks, it will be assigned a more restrictive tier by the State. County public health officials are constantly monitoring data and can implement additional public health measures as necessary.

The following are status updates for specific industries as published by the State. The status for these industries/businesses will change as each county’s COVID-19 tier changes.
