

# City of La Habra **Recommended Plant and Tree List**

Welcome to the Recommended Plant and Tree List, provided to you by the City of La Habra! Thank you for considering replacing your current "thirsty" plants with those that have a lower need for water. The trees and plants listed are by no means exclusive, however, provide a basic list of "tried and true" materials for our area. Here are some additional pointers and definitions to assist you in choosing the right plants for your yard or garden:

- · Choose planting locations based on the amount of sunlight and or water needed for the plant to thrive. Plants and trees with similar watering needs should be grouped together.
- Water any new plant or tree immediately after planting and continue to give the plant more water than usual and fertilize as needed while the plant is growing and acclimating. "California Native" and "Drought tolerant" plants and trees still need to be watered, particularly when they are first planted.
- · Proper maintenance of "Calilfornia Native" and "Drought tolerant" plants is required, including pruning and preventing overgrowth.
- Consult with a local nursery or landscape architect for plant-specific requirements.
- "California Native" are those species which occur naturally in the state and are acclimated to the local environment.
- "Deciduous" refers to plants or trees that drop most of their leaves at some time during the year, usually in autumn.
- "Drought Tolerant" describes plants that tolerate low water climates and are climate-adapted to arid regions.
- "Evergreen" describes plants that maintain most of their leaves throughout the year.

#### **Trees**

### Description



Arbutus unedo (Strawberry Tree)

- ✓ Low water use tree
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Grows between 20 to 40 feet tall
- √ Slow to moderate growth rate



Brachychiton acerifolius (Bottle Tree)

- ✓ Drought tolerant
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Grows up to 50 feet tall
- ✓ Slow to moderate growth




Chitalpa tashkentensis (Chitalpa)

- ✓ Drought tolerant
- ✓ Deciduous
- ✓ Grows between 20 to 30 feet tall
- ✓ Pink trumpet shaped flowers

Cinnamomum camphora (Camphor Tree)

- ✓ Drought tolerant
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Grows over 50 feet tall
- √ Requires large space, grows massive



- ✓ Drought tolerant, once established
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Grows up to 100 feet tall
- √ Rapid growth rate



**Eucalyptus torquata (Coral Gum)** 

- ✓ Moderately drought tolerant
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Grows up to 20 feet tall
- ✓ Moderately fast growth rate





#### Tristania conferta (Brisbane Box)

- ✓ Drought resistant, when established
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Grows up to 60 feet tall
- ✓ Moderate to fast growth

#### **Shrubs**

### **Description**



Abelia grandiflora (Glossy Abelia)

- ✓ Drought tolerant
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Medium sized shrub
- ✓ Can be used to create a hedge

Agave americana (Century Plant)

- ✓ Drought tolerant
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Large sized shrub
- ✓ Spines on leaves

Agapanthus africanus (Lily-of-the-Nile)

- ✓ Low to moderate water use
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Flower stalks up to 3 feet high

Aloe species (Aloe)

- ✓ Drought tolerant
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Small to medium sized shrub
- √ Spines on leaves

Amorpha canescens (False Indigo)

- ✓ Drought tolerant
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Small sized shrub

Archillea millefolium (Common Yarrow)

- ✓ California Native
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Small sized shrub

Arctostaphylos edmundsii (Little Sur Manzanita)


- ✓ California Native
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Small to medium sized shrub
- ✓ Does well in heavy soils

Caesalpinia pulcherrima (Red Bird of Paradise)

- ✓ Little to Moderate Water ✓ May be Evergreen in Mild Winters
- ✓ Fast, dense growth to 10 feet tall and wide
- ✓ Dark green leaves with many 3/4 inch leaflets

Callistemon citrinus (Dwarf Bottle Brush)

- ✓ Low to Moderate Water
- ✓ Drought tolerant
- ✓ Grows up to 3 feet tall
- ✓ Bright red 4 inch long brushes





Raphiolepis indica (Pink Indian Hawthorn)

- ✓ Low water use once established
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Medium to large sized shrub
- ✓ Used for creating hedges
- ✓ Little to moderate water in full sun
- ✓ Some species are hardier than others
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Becomes woody with age

Salvia (Sage)

Rosmarinus officinalis (Rosemary)

- ✓ Low water use
- ✓ Water and sun exposure varies between
- species
- ✓ Fire resistant

# **Groundcover**

#### **Description**

Carpobrotus edulis (Ice Plant, Hottentot Fig)

- ✓ Little to moderate water
- Succulent leaves
- Can rot in very wet conditions and can suffer dieback without water during growth period
- √ Full sun or partial shade
- ✓ Moderate to regular water
- Cephalophyllum 'Red Spike' (Red Spike Ice Plant) ✓ Provide supplemental water during active growth bloom
  - Cistus salvifolius (White Dwarf Rockrose)
- ✓ Little to no water in full sun
- ✓ Wide spreading shrub 2 feet high and 6 feet wide
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Good bank or ground cover for rough situations
- ✓ Low to moderate water
- ✓ Perennial ornamental strawberry
- ✓ Afternoon shade in the hottest climates
- ✓ Regular water

Gazania spp. (Gazania)

Fragaria chilolensis (Wild Strawberry)

- ✓ Moderate to regular water
- ✓ Perennials, some grown as annuals
- ✓ Sun exposure varies by species

Lantana spp. (Lantana)

- ✓ Low water use
- Some shade in the hottest climates
- Excellent ground cover
- ✓ Tends to "mound"

Senecio serpens (Blue Chalk Fingers)

- ✓ Drought tollerant
- ✓ Succulent
- ✓ Excellent ground cover
- √ Rapidly spreads



# **Vines**

# **Description**



Bougainvillea (Bougainvillea)

- ✓ Drought tolerant
- ✓ Evergreen
  ✓ Does not cling to walls needs to be
  - affixed
- √ Thorns deter climbing
- Ficus pumila (Creeping Fig)
- ✓ Low water use
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Clings to walls
- ✓ Should be kept cut short and close to wall
- Hedera helix (English Ivy)
- ✓ Low water use in shady areas
- ✓ Evergreen
- ✓ Will cling to walls
- ✓ May damage exterior stucco walls
- Low water use
- Rampant grower
- Should be supported by fence does not cling to walls
- ✓ Full sun or partial shade
- Macfadyena unguis-cati (Cat Claw Vine)
- Drought-resistant
- Vigorous grower
- Prefers full sun
- Will cling to walls and fences
- Wisteria spp. (Wisteria)
- Little to moderate water
- Twining woody vines of great size with a long life and beautiful flowers
- Should be supported by trellis or arbor
- Full sun
